Scholarship Information:

Basic Class Scholarships(not for Hockey 1 - 4):

Any youth(4-17 years of age)from families living in the Minot area who enroll in any of the Learn to Skate Basic Skills Classes may be eligible for a scholarship if they meet the requirements listed below. Includes free use of MCFSC lease skates(if skate size is available). A limited number of scholarship and lease skates are available on a first come first served bases.

If you wish to apply for a scholarship, please **pay** the appropriate USFS/Club **registration fee**, mark the Mon. Class or Wed. Class (do not pay the class fee), and fill out the **scholarship paragraph** on the registration form. **Hockey 1-4 skaters are not eligible** for scholarships. Form with payment can be mailed if **postmarked by Sept 6th**. Otherwise it **MUST** be turned in during registration time. Scholarship applicants needing club lease skates **MUST BE** available during registration time for fitting and skate care. All applicants who mail it in will be contacted before classes start.

MCFSC Payment Policy: NO MCFSC member will be allowed to skate without a completed registration form along with the initial payment turned in. Skaters will not be allowed to register for or skate during this session unless the previous session has been paid in full. Skaters with overdue balances are considered not in good standing and cannot test or compete anywhere until their account has been paid in full.

Only ENROLLED skaters are allowed on the ice.

Parents are strongly encouraged to remain at the rink the entire time that their child is skating.

Annual US Figure Skating/Club Registration Fee:

Each skater MUST pay the 2011 registration fee this session--**UNLESS** you paid it in June or July for 2011.

The fee is: \$20.00 for 1st skater and \$15.00 for each additional skater. This non-refundable fee is good through June 30, 2011

No refunds will be given without a Doctor's excuse.

Wed. Hockey 1: introductory class for the very beginner skater.

Class teaches the basic fundamentals of hockey skating--Ages 4 and up. Skaters must also pay the annual registration fee.

Skating Apparel: The arena is chilly--hat, gloves, & warm comfortable clothes are recommended. Jeans are NOT recommended. Shorts and skirts are allowed if worn with tights.

Wed. Freeskate(non class): 7:30-8:30pm **\$57 starts Sept 1**
