



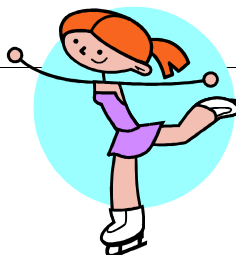
MCFSC NEWS

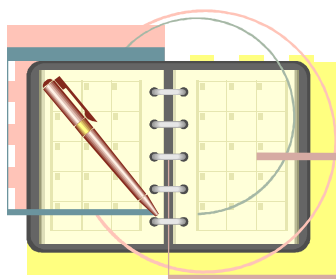
