

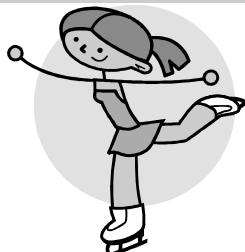


MCFSC NEWS

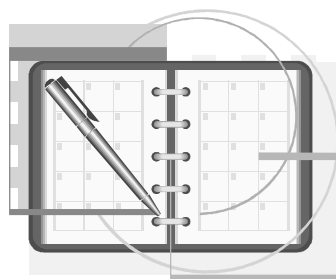
