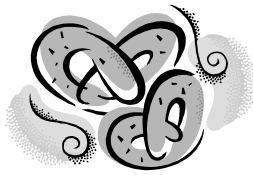
A special thank-you to Chase Fishpaw for being the dance partner for this test session!! Our girls would not have done so well without you, and we would be honored to have you back!!

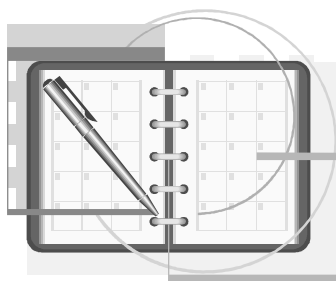
